LICENSE AND TROPHY FEES

TERMS and CONDITIONS

- A deposit of 50% of the total daily rate, plus concession fee, plus safari license is required to confirm your booking
- No deposits will be refunded for cancellation 6 months prior of contracted date. Deposit maybe forwarded to the following year, depending on our bookings. Hunt balance & animal license fees are due NLT May 1st of safari year.
- Trophy fees are payable on completion of your safari. Animal license fees are non-refundable by Zambian law.
- Should an agent be involved in your booking, the agent's commission will be deducted, before refund of your deposit.
- Trophy charges are applicable to animals killed or wounded and lost. Blood drawn is counted as a wounded and lost animal.
- All charges are subject to change due to Gov't. changes to Safari Co. fees. Payments must be made in cash or prior transfer.
- A maximum of 7 different species are permitted on Mini safaris. All species of plains game can be hunted on safari, except Roan antelope, which are reserved for Classic safaris only.



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ZAMBIA-LUANGWA VALLEY-WEST PETAUKE GMA-ZAMBIA BIG GAME HUNTING SAFARIS

The pristine 1,000,000 acre West Petauke Game Management Area is situated in the South Luangwa Valley, an extension of the famous Rift Valley. Renowned for its unspoilt beauty and varied habitats the Luangwa Valley supports one of Africa's richest concentrations of wildlife and birds. The geology is varied and embraces both escarpments and valley floor. Dry sandy riverbeds, streams and lagoons create the ideal habitat for the hunting of big game. Elevation runs from 1200meters (4300ft.) in the hills to 450meters (1350 ft.) at river level.

Safaris are normally conducted following the traditional style of walk and stalk and although we make use of fully equipped safari vehicles we adhere to the old hunting traditions, without compromising success. For bow hunters we offer makeshift blinds at selected natural waterholes. Safaris are often tailor-made to suit individual needs. The Luangwa riverbank offers some of the finest hunting on foot found anywhere in Africa.

The ultimate adventure is only for those who enjoy the rigors of walking and the thrill of the chase in a specialized Buffalo hunt. The hunt is conducted in hill country where large cantankerous bulls live out their last days in isolation. In traditional style a select team of porters and trackers will porter the necessary equipment deep into the foothills of the Muchinga escarpment. It is one of the finest hunts available and shooting is often up close and personal. A fully equipped lightweight camp enables us to follow the movement of these bulls.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Season: Hunting is from the 1 June to 30 November

Health Precautions:

Zambia is a malaria area. Prophylactics are essential with your doctor's approval. **Yellow Fever vaccines are compulsory and a proof there of has to be shown.** Hepatitis A and B vaccines are also recommended but first check with your Physician. First Aid is on hand in camp. Medical insurance is strongly advised.

International Flight Route: From country of origin to Johannesburg to Kenneth Kaunda International Airport (Lusaka). An SES representative will meet you at Kenneth Kaunda International Airport and assist you through customs for arrival and departure. Our representative will also transfer you to your charter or hotel accommodation and assist you with any other need.

Customs and Immigration: You will be issued a visa on arrival. This costs \$150.

Charter flight:

- Route, from Lusaka to West Petauke and return.
- Cost: +-\$3000/Cessna 206. The cost of a charter flight may vary according to number of people and type of plane, over which we have no control.



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Export of Trophies:

- A basic fee of \$1000 is charged per client for a mini safari and \$1500 per client is charged for a classic safari, for dip, crate and export documentation for the export of trophies.
- These fees do not cover export from Zambia to your home country.

Climate:

Temperatures vary from 8 degrees Celsius (48 F) in the mornings to 34 Celsius (90F) during midday for June, July and August. However September, October and November is our hot season and daytime temperatures can rise to between 35 and 40 Celsius (110F)

Clothing:

During the months of June/July/August a light down jacket or fleece is recommended. Later in the season a light-hunting jacket might be required in the mornings. Care must be taken not to use safari clothes of a light color. Grey, dark green or camo is recommended in the hunting field. Long sleeve shirts and trousers will protect the hunter from the sun. A cap or floppy hat is essential.

Game Species:

The Luangwa valley is famous for its population of Lion and Leopard. Hippo and crocodile frequent the rivers and lagoons. The bush bordering the river offers excellent opportunities for walk and stalk and supports a host of other species such as Waterbuck, Chobe Bushbuck and Puku. The Mopani forest and undulating hills are home to Buffalo, Roan, Kudu and Sharp's Grysbok.

Accommodations:

Hunting is conducted from two camps. The main camp, Sansi Camp, is situated on the west bank of the Luangwa River and includes comfortable safari-style chalets with en-suite bathroom. Power is supplied by both solar and generator. Meals are enjoyed in a central dining room with magnificent views of the river and surrounding countryside. This camp is built from natural materials in traditional African safari style.

The second camp, Lukushashi Camp, is located on the bank of the Lumsemfwa River on the Western edge of the hunting concession and includes comfortable safari-style tents with en-suite bathroom. Power is supplied by both solar and generator. Meals are enjoyed in a central dining room with magnificent views of the river and surrounding countryside. This camp is built from natural materials in traditional African safari style. This camp is famous for its very large crocodiles and outstanding tiger fishing.
